Did you know?

Basic behaviour patterns regarding smoking are imprinted in pre-school ages!



Protect children: don't make them breathe your smoke

Every third pre-school-aged child (kindergartener) lives in passive smoking home environment! According to the data collection of the Global Youth Tobacco Survey 2008- GYTS international research project in Hungary:

- more than half of 13-15 year-old students have tried smoking in their life,
- every fifth of smokers tried smoking (first cigarette) before they are 10 year-old!

Smoking prevention programs should be implemented from the age, when negative effects with a motivation for smoking reach children, and modify their current and future health behaviour.

What can we do?

Save pre-school aged children from harmful smoke! Till today in Hungary the first and the most notable smoking prevention program for kindergarteners is the Smoking Prevention Program in Kindergartens of the Focal Point for Tobacco Control, National Institute for Health Development (FPTC NIHD). Every kindergarten can participate in this interesting, age specific and gamesome program free of charge. By support of

methods and tools of the program, attitude changing for rejection of smoking and knowledge increasing develop in children. Development of skill of active action against passive smoking in kids is an important aim of the program. According to more researches including the impact assessment supported by the European Regional Office of WHO the program is trully effective!

The program focuses the attention of participants on the importance of healthy, smoke free lifestyle by a game software, Portable Touch Screen Computer (PTSC) and homepage (www.cikiacigi.hu) considering interest of children and youth. The PTSC coordinated to schools by the regional and local offices of National Public Health and Medical Officer Service. Text information, games (puzzle, coloring, tig, interactive cartoons, memory games) motivating for smoke free lifestyle or quitting, pictures of harmful effects of smoking, short films and animations are available for children.

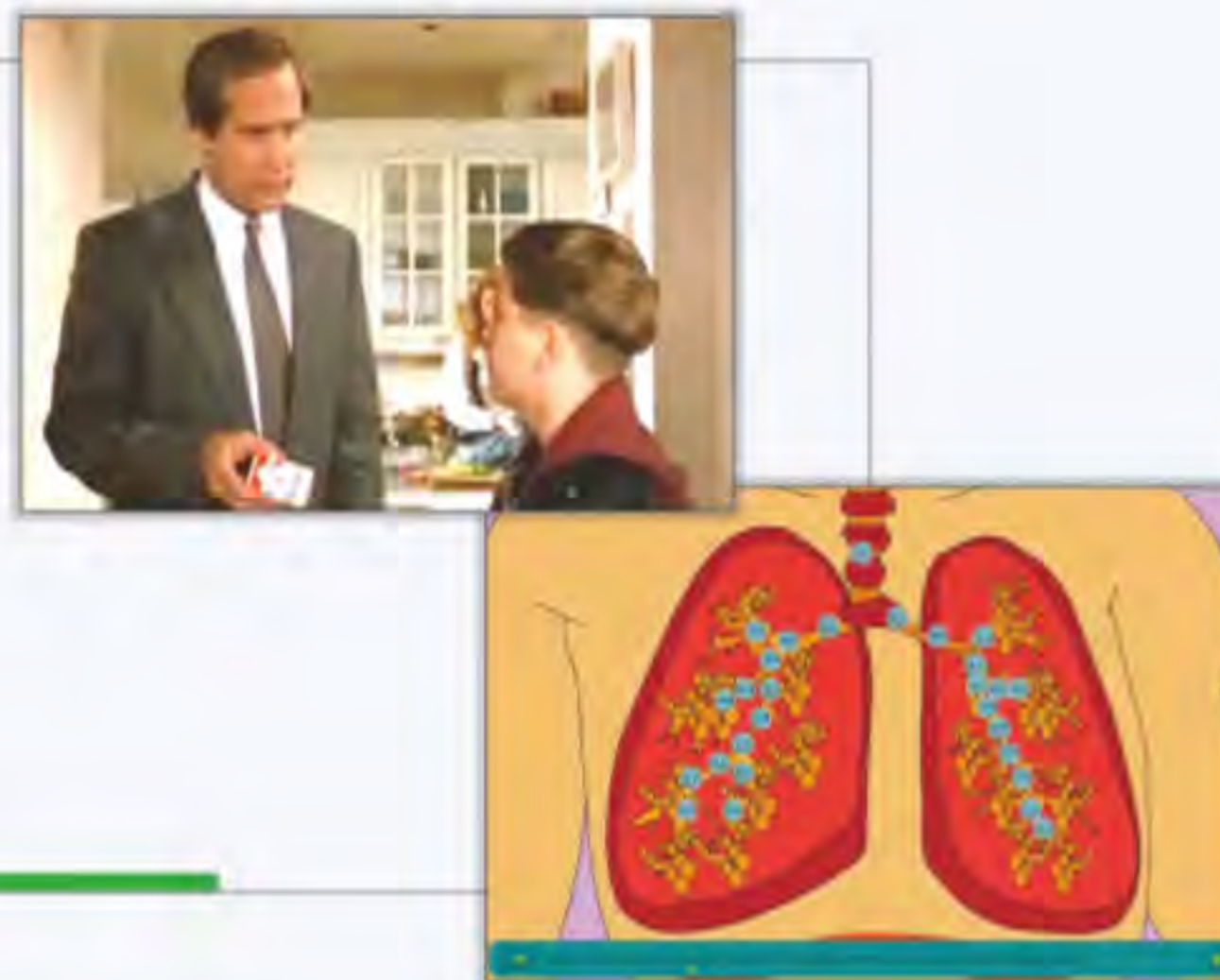


Is there any smoking prevention education, training program and tool package which could be incorporated into school syllabus?

Yes, FPTC NIHD can also provide solution free of charge! A syllabus and an interactive tool package are available for 3-5. and 6-10. grades. The main topics for processing are: history of smoking, decisions and choices regarding healthy lifestyle, social influence, diseases caused by smoking, harmful effects of passive smoking, addiction, environmental and economic effects, ingredients of cigarette and advantages of non-smoking lifestyle. Package of tools contains an interactive projectable presentation including more than 100 slides with coloured pictures, animations, movie parts. Beside these a text-assistant-book and a lifelike sized, knockdown demonstration puppet presenting diseases caused by smoking are also included to ease the realization of presentation.



The program by exciting tools, uniquely arrests children's attention and develops their attitude against smoking, increases their knowledge about harmful effects of smoking in a playful and easy way.
